Remember:

Take it slow and easy as you join these 2 curved pieces together, I found it helpful to use my darning foot instead of my usual presser foot, so I could see the guide stitching, though you have to work a bit to make sure it doesn't jump around!

Tip: The "cup" is divided into 3 colours. I've designated what fabric you are to use by
Cup A - one side
Cup B- opposite side
Cup C- inside lip.

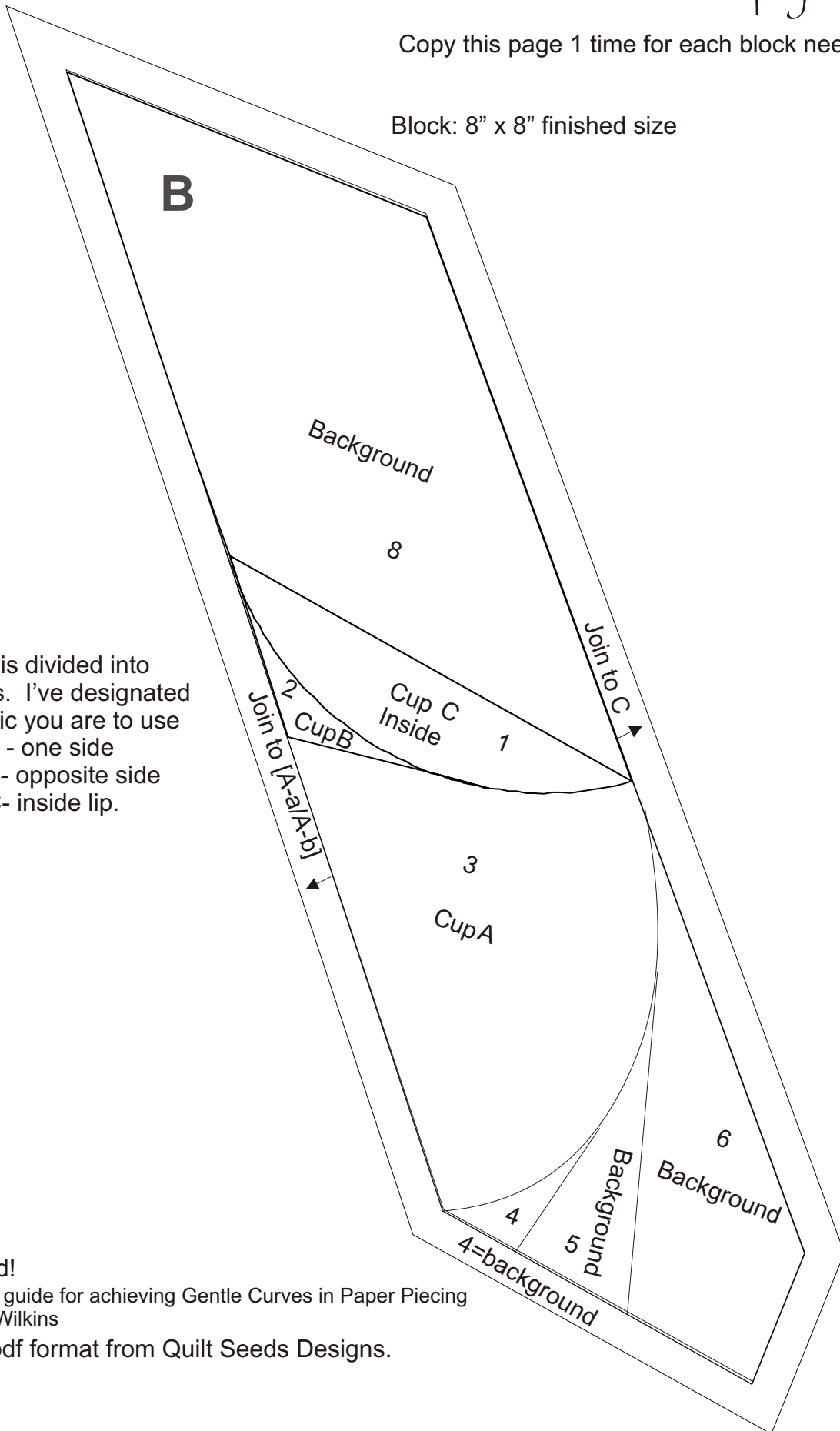
